(It is usually the responsibility of each committee's (A, B C &amp; D) Chair to cast it's one vote.)     </li> <li>Before the vote takes place, each committee group is provided the courtesy to decide how it's group will vote. This will consider the votes of its members present and those votes submitted by proxy.         As the meeting is online, breakout rooms will be made available for each committee group, as appropriate.     </li> <li>Each committee Chair (or nominated present member from that committee group) will then advise SACRE of the committee group's one vote.</li> <li>Once all the committee groups have voted and the vote has taken place, the ASC is dissolved and the LA must adopt the syllabus, assuming that it is satisfied that it 'reflects the fact that the religious traditions in Great Britain are in the main Christian while taking account of the teaching and practices of the other principal religions [and beliefs] represented in Great Britain' [Schedule 21, paragraph 10 2(b)]</li> </ol>	JJ JW'ton RN Chair (LB)
