We gather as a community for collective worship that is **inspiring**, **invitational and inclusive**, reflecting the fact that we are a part of a diverse school family and the wider church community. At the beginning of a new term and a brand new year, we begin a new series of themes, reflecting on the life and writings of King David, who contributed much of the content of the book of Psalms in the Bible. We are using the title 'Songs from the heart', because this is exactly what the Psalms were: heartfelt expressions of joy, sadness, frustration, hope and longing, giving voice to experiences and emotions that pupils of all faiths and none can relate to. We know that not all children like to sing, so please do

make sure they understand that the word 'song' can also be understood metaphorically as a way of expressing what's in our hearts – and that although we may use songs during this term, there is no compulsion to sing during your collective worship! We will also be linking to some beautiful readings / videos of the Psalms, for you to use if they are helpful. Because Easter Day is just before the start of the Summer term, we will be marking Resurrection Day on the first day of the summer term, so are deliberately leaving the term on a cliffhanger!
